The signs often advertise financial opportunities, weight loss experiments, yard sales, etc. At that time I explained BGE's manpower constraints, and you offered to remove the advertisements provided we supply you written permission.

Accordingly, BGE grants you, Leonard Wasilewski, and Gary Bennett permission to remove existing and future signs/advertisements attached to BGE poles. Sign removal authorization includes only those signs which are no greater than 12' above the ground. If a sign has a distance greater than 12' above the ground please contact me at 410-291-3730 to arrange for BGE personnel to remove the sign.

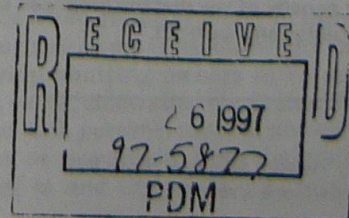
